NATIONAL EVENTS

• Nitin Gadkari inaugurated first interstate bridge over Ravi River in J&K: On January 22, 2019, Nitin Gadkari inaugurated first inter-state 1210-meter span-bridge over Ravi River in Keerian Gandial in Kathua District, Jammu and Kashmir. It was built at a cost of Rs 158.84 crore in a span of three and a half years linking areas of Katthua district with Punjab.

ii.The bridge also called as Keediyan-Gandiyal bridge will benefit over 2,20,000 people living on the two sides – Kathua in

Jammu, and Pathankot in Punjab. It will reduce the distance between the two cities from 45 kms to 8.6 kms.

• PM Narendra Modi Inaugurates Country's First National Museum of Indian Cinema in Mumbai On 19th January 2019, Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi launched the Country's First National Museum of Indian Cinema in Mumbai, Maharashtra, that seeks to portray over a century-old journey of movies in India.

- **Indians** biggest supporters of international aid: WEF global survey The World Economic Forum (WEF) released a survey ahead of its annual which states that **Indians** are meeting supporters biggest of international aid. **95%** of Indians supported international aid and expect India to help other nations.
- 4th Arab Economic and Social Development Summit Held In Beirut, Lebanon On 20th January 2019, the 4th Arab Economic and Social Development Summit took place in Lebanon's capital Beirut in which the Arab leaders have

agreed a 29-item economic agenda in addition to encouraging the safe return of Syrian refugees to their homeland.

• Palestine took over the Chair of the Group of 77 (G-77) for 2019 from Egypt On January 15, 2019, Palestine took over the chairmanship of the Group of 77 from Arab Republic of Egypt. i. Prior to this, Egypt was the previous Chair of the bloc which is a coalition of 134 developing countries, along with China.

ii. The decision to elect Palestine as **2019 Chair of the G77** was taken in September 2018 by the foreign ministers of the Groups' member States.

- Raghbir Singh Bhola On January 22, 2019, Former India hockey player Raghbir Singh Bhola, has passed away at the age of 92 in New Delhi.
- **Tony Mendez** On January 20, 2019, Former CIA agent Tony Mendez, who inspired the Oscar-winning film *Argo*, has died at the age of 78 due to Parkinson's Disease in Frederick, Maryland.
- Jagjit Singh Chopra On January 19, 2019, Padma Bhushan neurologist Jagjit Singh Chopra has died at the age of 84.
 i. He was the founder of the department of neurology at PGIMER, Chandigarh.

• Masazo Nonaka On 20th January 2019, World's oldest man Masazo Nonaka died due to natural causes in the Japan's northern most island of Hokkaido at the age of 113.

- Arunachal: Arunachal govt declares Pakke Paga Hornbill Festival as 'state festival' On 20th January 2019, Arunachal Pradesh Chief Minister, Pema Khandu declared Pakke Paga Hornbill Festival (PPHF) as the "State Festival" during a valedictory ceremony of the fourth edition of the festival at Seijosa in East Kameng district, Arunachal Pradesh.
- Tiruchirappalli: On Jan 20, 2019, Defence Minister Nirmala Sitharaman launched a series of projects as a part of the Tamil Nadu Defence Industrial Corridor in Tiruchirappalli. This is considered to be the second corridor succeeding the one launched in Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh.

AWARDS

- Kohli first player to win all three top ICC awards in single year-ICC Awards 2018 On 22nd January 2019, 30-year-old Indian Cricket Team Captain, Virat Kohli became the first player to bag all top three ICC Awards in a single year. He won the Sir Garfield Sobers Trophy for ICC Cricketer of the Year, the ICC Men's Test Player of the Year and the ICC Men's ODI Player of the year for his performance in 2018.
- Bharat Ratna CNR Rao chosen for Sheikh Saud International Prize for Materials Research On 19th January 2019, Centre for Advanced Materials of the United Arab Emirates (UAE) chose Eminent Scientist and Bharat Ratna

recipient CNR Rao for the first Sheikh Saud International Prize for Materials Research.

- UNESCO names Rio de Janeiro as World Capital of Architecture for 2020 On 18th January 2019, The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) named Rio de Janeiro, a city in Brazil as the World Capital of Architecture for 2020.
- WHO Goodwill ambassador Yohei Sasakawa received Gandhi Peace Prize for 2018 On January 17, 2019, Yohei Sasakawa was named to receive Gandhi Peace Prize for 2018, who is the Goodwill Ambassador of the World Health Organization for Leprosy Elimination. The award will be given to Yohei Sasakawa in recognition of his work towards the eradication of the disease in India and across the world.

- Khelo India Youth Games: Hosts Maharashtra finish top with 228 medals On 20th January 2019, the Khelo India Youth Games concluded at the Shiv Chhatrapati Sports Complex, Balewadi in Pune with the host Maharashtra leading the medals table by winning a mammoth 85 gold, 62 silver and 81 bronze for a total of 228 medals in the Games.
- Championships: Lovlina wins gold medal, Manisha settles for silver On 6th January 2019, World Championship bronze medallist Assam's Lovlina Borgohain claimed the gold medal while Haryana boxer Manisha Moun had to settle with silver at the Women's National Boxing Championships held at

- the JSW Sports' Inspire Institute of Sports, Vijayanagara, Karnataka.
- Ankita Raina wins ITF's tournament in Singapore On 20th January 2019, India's Ankita Raina won the International Tennis Federation's (ITF) 25,000-dollar Women's tournament in Singapore by defeating top seed and world number 122 Arantxa Rus of the Netherlands, by 6-3, 6-2.
- Saurashtra record highest successful chase in Ranji Trophy history Saurashtra has created history by successfully chasing a target of 372 runs in the second quarter final against Uttar Pradesh in the ongoing Ranji Trophy 2018-19 at Bharat Ratna Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee International Cricket Stadium in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh.
 - **i.** Saurashtra broke the record of Assam which had chased 371 runs against services in 2008-09 in Delhi.
 - **ii.** Saurashtra qualified for the semi-final with this win with a great knock from Rinku Singh who scored 150 runs.
- India 1st away team to win bilateral series in all formats in Australia On 18th January 2019, India defeated Australia in the third ODI at Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG) to win the ODI series by 2-1 and became the first Visiting team to win bilateral series across the three formats against Australia in Australian soil.

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

 US spy satellite launched into orbit from California On January 19, 2019,A powerful Delta 4 Heavy rocket carrying a U.S. spy satellite lifted off from California.

Important points to note

i. The central core booster's Aerojet Rocketdyne RS-68A engine continued fired until the upper stage's single RL10B-2 engine ignited to continue the climb to space. Details of the mission, dubbed NROL-71, were not released.

- **ii.** This was the second attempt after the launch was postponed because of a communication problem between the control center and the launch site.
- First in India: HAL-built light combat helicopter completes air-to-air weapon trials On 17th January 2019, Light combat helicopter (LCH), has successfully carried out air-to-air missile firing on a moving aerial target at the integrated test range in Chandipur on Odisha coast. This LCH is first in the country, which is designed and developed by Rotary Wing Research & Design Centre (RWRDC), Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL).
- ISRO to launch two unmanned space missions in 2020 and 2021 On 18th January 2019, ISRO announced that two unmanned space missions to be launched in the year 2020 and 2021.

Key points:

- i. Country's first manned space flight Gaganyaan will send three humans into space for seven days by December 2021, which will carry humanoids not animals.
- **ii.** Inorder to boost the Space Mission in India, the Union Cabinet had approved Rs 10,000 **crore** budget for the proposed human spaceflight mission.
- **iii.** ISRO would launch a one month 'Young Scientists programme to provide them with practical experience in building satellites.
- iv. ISRO will develop an incubation center at Tripura and four more will be created at Trichy, Nagpur, Rourkela, and Indore.

Japan launches Epsilon-4 rocket with 7 satellites On 18th January 2019, Japan launched the Epsilon – 4 rocket carrying 7 satellites including world's first artificial meteor shower blasted into space from the Uchinoura space centre by the Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA).
